All exhibitors will be required to sign a release regarding their birds health before their fowl will be allowed in the building.

1. Before entering, refer to General Information, Livestock Rules and Regulations, and Youth Rules.
2. Birds are to arrive on the grounds between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m Mon., 8/20. Birds to be released between 8 and 10 a.m. Sun, 8/26. The Superintendent and Fair are NOT responsible for any birds left after 10 a.m.
3. LIMIT: Two per class, per lot. 12 entries total per exhibitor.
4. Pigeon judging to take place Tue., 8/21. Pigeons will be judged by the National Pigeon Association standards.
5. Fitting and Showing will take place on Tue. following poultry. Fitting and Showing contestants will advance to the Small Animal Round Robin at 5 p.m Wed., 8/22. All 4-H contestants must enter Fitting and Showing in order to receive premium points.
6. All exhibitors must sign-up for barn duty. Pigeon herdsmanhip includes the entire barn. All exhibitors must keep their animals, barn area, and grooming area clean or monies will be withheld. Cages must be cleaned by 9 a.m. daily.
7. All exhibitors must provide their own feed and grit for the entire week. Superintendents are not responsible for providing or caring for supplies and equipment.
8. ABSOLUTELY NO BARN BIRDS.
9. All birds must be banded. Young birds seamless 2007 bands. Split bands must be entered as old birds.
10. FEATHER AUCTION WILL BE HELD AT NOON ON FRI, 8/24. Auction is held through the 4-H poultry department. Check Dept. 38 for rules. Forms must be to the Superintendent by 10 p.m. Wed., 8/22, in order to sell.
